Patent & Trademark Workshop at State Library tomorrow

- WHO:** **Inventors, entrepreneurs, legal professionals and others** interested in learning more about patents and trademarks have registered.
- WHAT:** The Arkansas State Library, The Small Business Development and Technology Center, Arkansas Regional Innovation Hub, Arkansas Women's Business Center, The Innovation Hub and the United States Patent and Trademark Office will be jointly hosting a public workshop.
- Two representatives from the USPTO office in Alexandria, VA and a representative from the new USPTO office in Dallas, TX will be leading the training.
